Award Ceremony – Saturday 23 October 2010

General Requirements for awards

Artist/musicians can nominate themselves, or can be nominated by a community member. Nominees must:

- reside in the Scenic Rim Regional Council area, or
- reside in the former Beaudesert Shire area, or
- be able to demonstrate a connection to the Scenic Rim Region or old Beaudesert Shire area

Under 26 nominees must not have turned 26 by 23rd October 2010

Award Details

1. Songwriting Award – High School

There is a limit of two songs per applicant. Each song entered must be on a separate CD with a print out of the lyrics. Songs should be in CD audio format or MP3. Please note quality of recording and production is not judged for this category - the focus is on the song. High school applicant must still be attending school in 2010.

2. Songwriting Award – Under 26's

There is a limit of two songs per applicant. Each song entered must be on a separate CD with a print out of the lyrics. Song should be in CD audio format or MP3. Please note quality of recording and production is not judged for this category - the focus is on the song.

3. Songwriting Award – Open

There is a limit of two songs per applicant. Each song entered must be on a separate CD with a print out of the lyrics. Song should be in CD audio format or MP3. Please note quality of recording and production is not judged for this category - the focus is on the song.

4. Lifetime Achievement Award

Nominations are called for a person who has demonstrated a commitment to music and/or the development of music and associated events over an extended number of years. This commitment could be for playing music, recording, producing, assistance to community groups, networking and promotion, mentoring musicians and working musicians' groups.

5. Music Achievement Award – Under 26's

Nominations are called for a young adult who has already shown expertise in learning and achieving in a musical field. This could include recording, study of instrument/vocals, success in eisteddfods, involvement in school activities, community and various musical projects.

6. Instrumentalist/Vocalist Award

Nominations are called for a person who has shown an exceptional amount of skill in a particular instrument and/or as a vocalist. This may be a person who has experience in performing and/or recording, or may be a band member. One piece of music, not exceeding 4 minutes must be submitted. This piece of music may be posted in on CD. This award will be judged not only on skill, but on proven dedication and commitment to the instrument or singing.

7. Music Video Award

Nominations will be accepted from musicians who have had a video clip made, or from music video makers. Either the musicians or the video makers must live in the designated area as per general requirements. Nominees must send their clip in a DVD player format **and** on a separate disc, in .avi or .mpeg format. The video must have been produced after 15 September 2009.

8. Community Group Music Performance

Nominations are encouraged from community groups (including musical theatre, drumming, community bands, school bands and choirs) who are based in the area as per General Requirements. The nominated performance may not necessarily have been performed in this area. The performance must have taken place after 15 September, 2009.
